BUILDING BLOCKS FOR YOUTH SUCCESS IN THE TRADES

THE FACTS

- 74% of employers find essential skills relevant to their business (ABC Life Literacy, 2013)
- Employers report that graduates are coming to their workplace with only 30% of the skills needed for the job
- Canadians aged 16-24 rank below average in their literacy and numeracy skills compared to 23 other countries (OECD, 2012)
- In Canada, about 28% of your earnings is directly related to your Essential Skills
- Apprentices with the Essential Skills they need for their Trade are 8 times more likely to pass their technical exams

Having an employee with a higher level Essential Skills is much more valuable to potential employers because the individual will have:

- an attention to safety
- the ability to work in a team setting
- a greater aptitude in problem solving
- improved client service skills
- an ability to adapt to change
- an advanced knowledge of numerical skills, including estimation, budgeting and calibrations

Skills shortages remain a significant challenge for Canada. Our country supports initiatives that help ensure Canadians have the Essential Skills needed to participate fully in the labour market and in their communities.
