Last June, we were fortunate enough to receive the Stanley DeWalt grant for hand tools. The Skills Canada National Competition was held in Moncton, New Brunswick and the host province's schools could apply for this very generous gift.

We received many hand tools, including drill bits, measuring tapes, levels and power tools that included grinders, rotary files, circular saws, biscuit jointers, palm sanders, etc.

I shared several cordless drills with Fundy High School, St. Stephen Middle School, and Sussex High. Further, since I teach Metal courses and not Carpentry, I gave the majority of the carpentry-based tools to the Carpentry program here at SSHS. These tools will have an immense effect on our programs for years to come.

These quality DeWalt and Stanley tools will assist us greatly in fabrication projects as well as safety training for our students.
